I must say again that my reason for including material like this is not to ridicule or attack the many good Christians who are tolerant and who oppose the theocrats as much as we do. I have no ill will toward Christians - after all, most of my recent ancestors have been Christians! - but those who would limit freedoms to the rest of us must be exposed for what they are.

Above all, the point is this - we must make the connection in people's minds between our pre-Christian, European heritage and today's institutions of liberty!

BORN FIGHTING: HOW THE SCOTS-IRISH SHAPED AMERICA

You may wonder how James Webb's book ended up on the AFA Update, since it clearly is about the Scots and Irish rather than the Germanic peoples. If you have examined a copy of Born Fighting, however, the relevance will be obvious. Webb is enthusiastic about ancestry, particularly his own - and one which is shared by many of the readers of this update.

Webb's contention is that the culture of the Scots-Irish is, to a surprisingly large extent, the culture of Middle America. He traces our individualism (and our corresponding clannishness), our pioneering spirit, and our distrust of authority to this enterprising and cantankerous ethnic group. On the one hand, I believe he overlooks the fact that these elements are found to some extent in all the European immigrants to America's shores. He nevertheless makes a strong case for a disproportionately strong Scots-Irish influence on the traditional American way of life.

Hadrian's Wall stretched from east to west across northern England, marking a line close to what is, today, the border between England and Scotland. Roman rule stopped at that line. Later, feudalism in Scotland never took root beyond a rather superficial level, because of the Scottish insistence on being ruled by clans, with such government as there was built from the bottom up, and leaders chosen by the clansmen. Webb describes how this independent people, bottled up from the south, applied their energies to migrations, trade, and warfare back and forth between Scotland and northern Ireland. It is from this exchange that the Scots-Irish developed.

Although Webb does not put it in these terms, we might conclude that Scotland - protected as it was from Roman rule and, to a large extent, from the ill effects of feudalism - preserved the pre-Christian attitudes and social structure better than the rest of Europe. To the extent this is true, it makes sense for us, whether Celtic or Germanic or what have you, to examine the Scots and the Scots-Irish in detail.

Such knowledge is particularly relevant to our goal of taking the message of Asatru to a larger audience. As the leftists say, "To take the revolution to the people, you have to go to where the people are at." Webb's book is helpful to those of us who need to understand just what it is that moves and shapes our key target audience.
